



Dear Parent/Carer

RE: Priory Rise Nursery

Thank you for your interest in a nursery place for your child at Priory Rise.

We offer sessions, Monday to Friday, during term time.

For continuity of the children's learning experience, we offer places based on the following:

- 5 morning sessions (8:50am – 11:50am) or
- 5 afternoon sessions (12:20pm – 3:20pm) or
- 5 full day sessions (8:50am – 3:20am)

We offer both 15 and 30 hour government funded places.

Our 15 hour funded places are offered as 5 morning sessions or 5 afternoon sessions.

Our 30 hour funded places are offered as 8:50am-3:20pm, Monday to Friday, with a chargeable lunchtime supervision period (11:50am-12:20pm). This lunchtime supervision period is charged at £3.50 per day.

All extended nursery hours (those not eligible for a 30 hour government funded place) will be charged at a rate of £16.50 per session. For example, if you have been offered a 15 hour funded place, but wish your child to attend 5 full day sessions.

For any children staying all day, a packed lunch from home will need to be provided. Alternatively, a hot lunch can be ordered through Arbor (our Parent Portal). A hot lunch for a child in our nursery is charged at £2.25 per day.

At the time of application, please state your preference for morning or afternoon sessions. Whilst we will try our best to accommodate your preference, this cannot be guaranteed. Please also bring your child's birth certificate with the application form, as we are required to make a copy of it to keep on file. You will be notified if your child has been offered a place, in the term prior to when your child is eligible to start nursery.
