At the end of the Foundation Stage children are assessed against each of the 17 Early Learning Goals (ELG). Children are assessed as either 'emerging' or 'expected' in each of the ELGs and are considered to have reached a good level of development (GLD) if they have achieved at least the expected level in the prime areas of learning of

- Personal, Social and Emotional development
- Physical Development
- Communication and Language

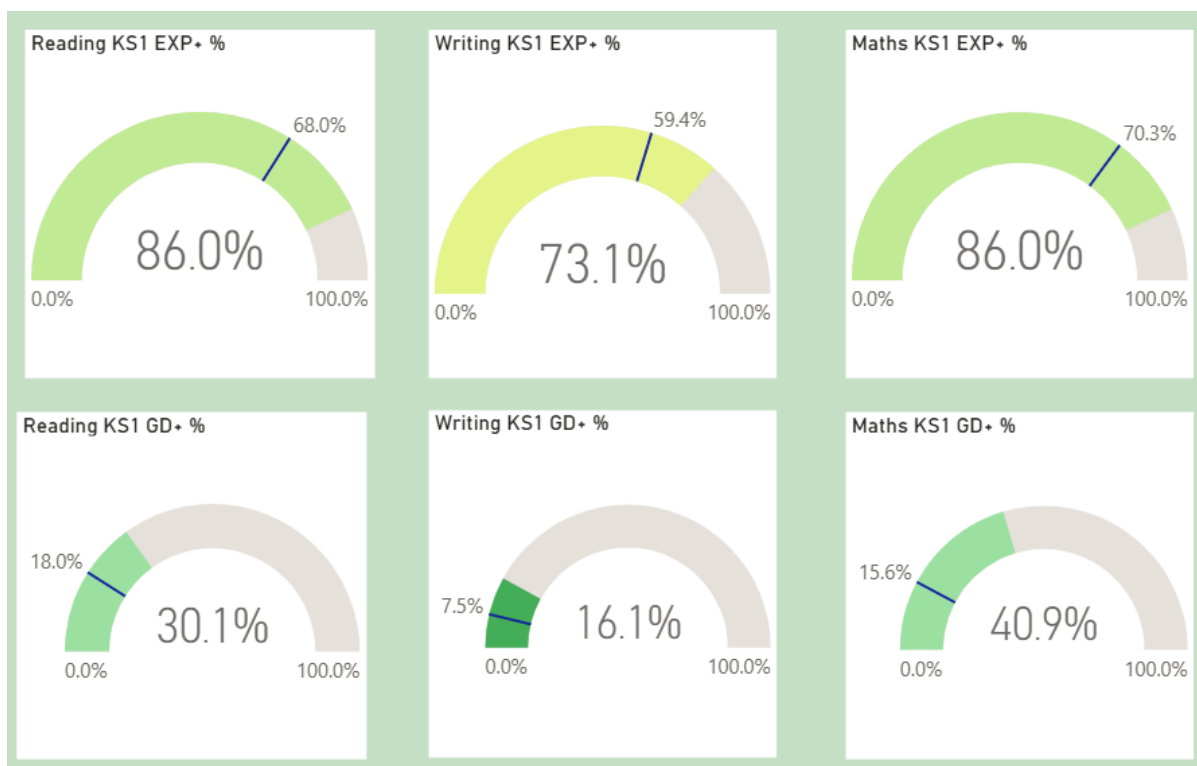

- Mathematics

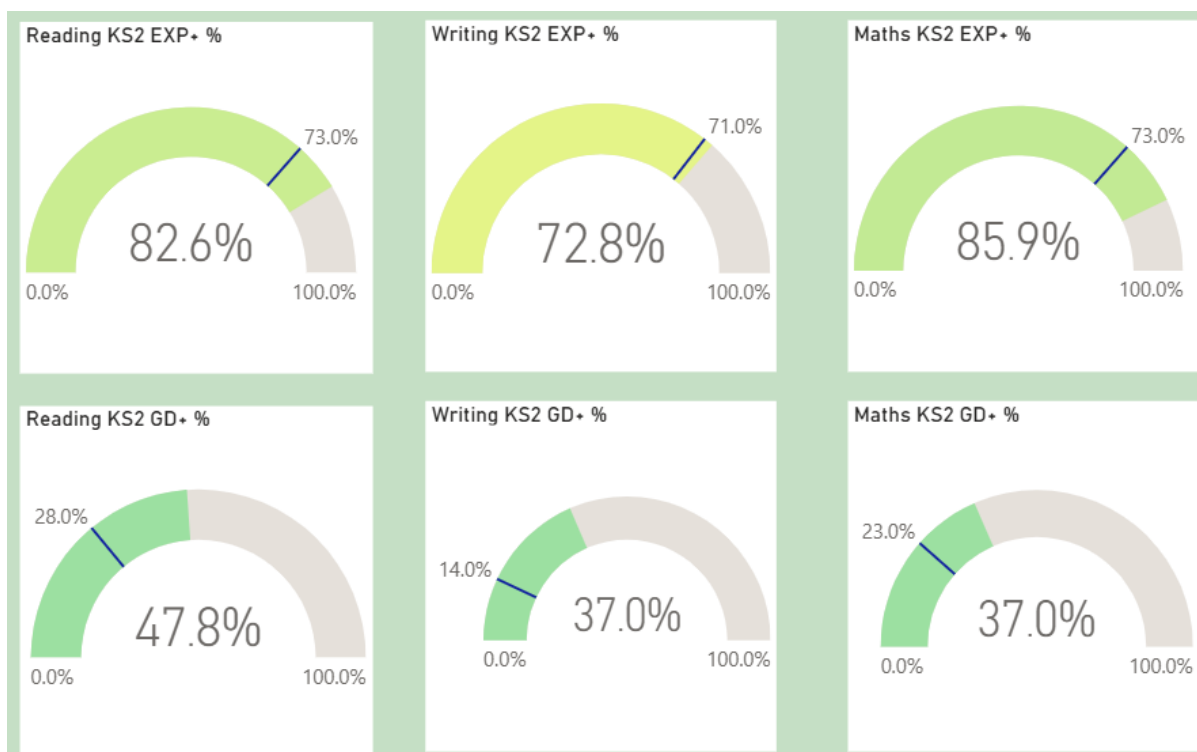
Results for the academic year 2023-2024 - the black line across the scales are national results, and the green shading are Priory Rise School results
