Therefore, during the coming years your child may be taking part in activities outside the school premises and perhaps also outside school hours. We will always give you information in advance of any such visits and seek your written permission for your child to take part in these activities.

In very rare circumstances children may fall ill on a school visit or have an accident which requires medical treatment. In this very unlikely situation we would of course contact you immediately. However, in the unlikely event of your child needing very urgent treatment and us not being able to contact you, we would like your consent to authorise urgent medical treatment. We therefore ask parents to sign and return the form below in order that such consent may be given.

I agree that if my child requires urgent medical treatment during an out of school activity and it is not possible to contact us (mother/father with parental responsibility), the teacher in charge of the children on the visit is authorised to give consent on my behalf.
